THEORY PART:

- 1) Theory Examinations, both for Supplementary Preliminary and Supplementary Final for different Para Medical Courses will be held on and from 30.03.2022.**
- 2) Theory Examinations will be held through "OFFLINE" mode from 30.03.2022 to 02.04.2022 in ONE SITTING from 12 Noon to 2 P.M. at the Home centre of the respective Medical Colleges / Government Institutions / Affiliated Non-Government Institutions.**

- 3) Theory Question Papers for all Para Medical Courses in each Term i.e. Supplementary Preliminary and Supplementary Final, would be of **Objective Type** consisting of 20 MCQs [with four options], 10 True/False, 10 Match the Column "A" with "B" and 10 Fill-in-the Blanks.
- 4) Total numbers of questions are 50, carrying 1 mark each with no choice or option, with duration of Examination 2 hours, and, it would be doubled to equate full marks of 100 in each Paper. Pass Marks would be 50 in each paper.

VIVA PART:

- 1) The Viva Examinations in each Paper of each Para Medical Course, both Supplementary Preliminary and Supplementary Final, would be of 100 marks in one/two sittings or more (where number of students are more) with 10 Questions and each question will carry 10 marks with the duration of 10 minutes per student. Pass Mark is 50 in each paper.
- 2) Viva Examinations in each Para Medical Courses in each Institute will be conducted through **Offline** mode by the concerned Departments of Medical Colleges/Government Institutions/Affiliated Institutions within 7 days after completion of the Theory Examinations.
- 3) Clinical Assessment related to D.OPT Course (Final part) will be held through "Offline" mode along with the Viva simultaneously by the respective Institute within 7 days after completion of the Theory Papers.
