## IMPORTANT NOTICE

In re: Holding of Additional Practical Classes and  
Completion of Syllabus of each Para Medical  
Courses - request thereof :

Further to Faculty's Notice No. 759-F/10-2014 dated 09-06-2022 in respect of Internal Assessment and Attendance, it is to be noted that the regular examinations [Preliminary & Final] of all Para Medical Courses have been scheduled to be held, tentatively, in the month of September, 2022, and, as such, it has become essential that classes both in theory and in practical be arranged for the purpose of completing the rest of syllabus for Preliminary and Final Examinations, for the concerned students by all Institutes – by Medical Colleges/Govt Institutions /Affiliated Institutes. Besides, additional practical classes are also to be arranged in order to make up the shortfall during COVID-19 situation.

In this context, it is reiterated that criteria for appearing at the ensuing examinations [preliminary & final] have been decided to be maintained as follows :-

- 1 Re : Internal Assessment :  
Pass with 50% marks, individually, in Theory, in Practical, and, in Oral & Practical, would need to be obtained by a student to be eligible for appearing at the examinations. The students who would obtain marks below 50% in Internal Assessment, would not be sent up for appearing at the examinations by the Institutes.

### N.B.


Marks obtained in Internal Assessment by a student would not be incorporated as a component for adding to Pass Mark of any individual subject/paper, nor the same be shown in the Mark Sheet of the student.

- 2 Attendance :  
Minimum 75 % attendance is required to be secured by a student for appearing at the examinations.

However, for attendance- percentage secured by a student between 60 and 74 % [ sixty and seventy-four percent], a fine of Rs.2000/- [Rupees Two Thousand] per examination per course is to be paid by such a student for appearing at the examinations at Faculty Office.

Students with attendance percentage below 60 % are not allowed to appear at the examinations.

The Principals / the Directors / the Dean of Students Affairs / the Heads of Medical Colleges / Govt Institutions / Affiliated Institutions are requested to kindly be so good as to arrange for circulation of this Notice to all concerned.


